**Canadian Medical Hall of Fame Inductee**

Dr. Scriver is currently Professor of Pediatrics, Biology (Honorary) and Human Genetics in the Faculties of Medicine and Science at McGill University and Alva Professor of Human Genetics. He holds 4 honorary degrees (D.Sc.) and civil honours from Canada (CC) and Quebec (GOQ), and has been recognized through awards and prizes for his work in service, education and research. His current research is about human (population) genetic variation as revealed at the PAH (PKU) locus, the informatics involved in the HUGO Mutation Database Initiative, and new ways to treat genetic disease.

Dr. Scriver was inducted into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame in October 2001 for his lifetime contribution to human genetics.
