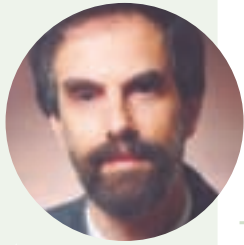


Health services research involves understanding how health care services can be better organized to contribute to human health.
