Health Care Visionary Dr. Harvey V. Fineberg is named the 2013 winner of the Henry G. Friesen International Prize in Health Research. The Prize, recognizes exceptional innovation by a visionary health leader of international stature.

Dr. Fineberg served as Provost of Harvard University from 1997 to 2001, following thirteen years as Dean of the Harvard School of Public Health. He has devoted most of his academic career to the fields of health policy and medical decision-making. His past research has focused on the process of policy development and implementation, assessment of medical technology, evaluation and use of vaccines, and dissemination of medical innovations.
