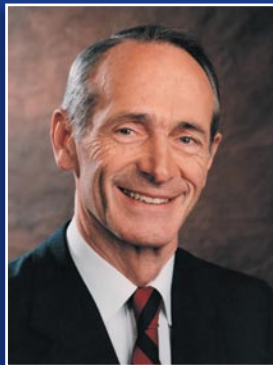
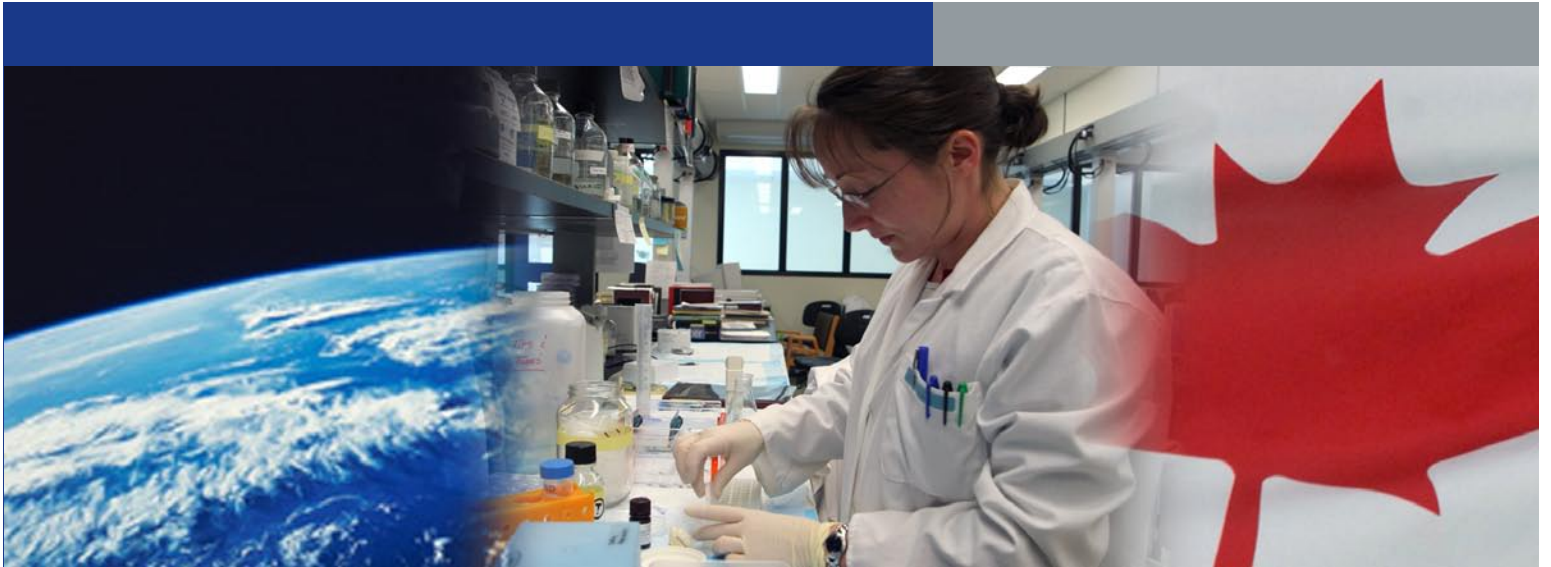


THE INFINITE HORIZON OF HEALTH RESEARCH: IS CANADA VISIBLE?
