



THE JANET ROSSANT LECTURESHIP (est. 2018)

and

PREAMBLE:

The Janet Rossant Lectureship was established at Massey College in recognition of Dr. Janet Rossant's distinguished career as a scientist, scholar, builder and leader in medical research. This, coupled with her dedicated mentorship of young scientists and scholars, is reflected in the purpose of this honour. This honorific Lectureship will attract accomplished visiting scientists to engage graduate students and faculty members alike, as part of the Massey Grand Rounds (MGR) program at Massey College.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Purpose:

To host promising health scientists and enliven the intellectual discourse at Massey College. To expand the exposure of Junior and Senior Fellows to advances in health research. To enhance the impact and interest in the annual Massey Grand Round Symposium.

Award:

The Award consists of a cash prize of \$2,000 CAD plus economy air fare, hotel and hospitality costs associated with the fulfillment of the Lecture and participation in the annual MGR Symposium. An engraved plaque commemorating the honour is presented.

Recipient Responsibilities:

- The Lecturer will deliver an address of approximately one hour in length that may be videorecorded for later broadcast online. The Lecture should appeal to a broad audience and present ideas in the spirit of Dr. Janet Rossant's long-standing contributions. An abstract of the lecture is to be submitted six weeks prior to the event for promotional purposes.
- The Lecturer will participate in the Massey Grand Rounds Symposium and meet with early career investigators and senior leaders over the 1 1/2 day visit, as appropriate.
- The Lecturer will be available for media interviews.

Governance:

An Advisory Committee made up of eight (8) members (including 2 Junior Fellow Co-Chairs of MGR) of the Massey community governs the Lectureship. The President of FCIHR (or his/her delegate) serves as Chair. Members of the Committee are drawn from the academic health research community. The Principal of Massey College (Principal Nathalie Des Rosiers) and Dr. Janet Rossant are ex-officio non-voting members. Vacancies are filled at the discretion of the Chair.

The Committee is responsible for the call and deadline for nominations, vetting submissions, evaluating nominees, selecting the Honouree, as well as establishing the annual Lecture and Award venues and all partnership and sponsorship arrangements. Accountability to the supporting organizations occurs annually.

Collaborations:

Massey College through the Massey Grand Rounds (MGR) program established the Lectureship in collaboration with Friends of CIHR. Other scientific organizations may be engaged to participate at the discretion of the Chair.

Sponsorship:

Organizations or institutions that wish to promote mentorship of graduate students in the health sciences and maximize their social, economic and health benefits may be eligible to co-sponsor the Lectureship.

Nominations:

Members of the Advisory Committee submit nominations. Information related to the nomination and selection process is confidential. Nomination forms are available online:
